professional-level singers.

ALL VOICES (SATB)  
are invited to audition.

Edmonton's own Pro Coro Canada was founded in 1981 and is one of only a few professional choirs in Canada. Under the direction of Michael Zaugg, and as a Winspear Resident Company, the choir is widely recognized as one of this country's best. Recent highlights include two live recording releases, a composer-in-residence program with internationally renowned Welsh composer Paul Mealor, and critically acclaimed tours of four provinces. Pro Coro Canada believes strongly in community partnerships and over the past few years has collaborated with eleven amateur choirs as well as mentoring emerging singers, composers and conductors through the #connect Program.

A list of substitute singers is maintained; these people may also be used to augment Pro Coro Canada if a larger group is needed.

An audition will last approximately twenty (20) minutes and consist of:

- PERFORMANCE: Anton Webern – "**Entflieht auf leichten Kähnen**" (the other parts will be played by the pianist.) This piece will be distributed to all auditioners
- PERFORMANCE: 2 Art Songs, no more than 4 minutes each, from after 1850, any composer, one selection in the English language, the other selection in German, Italian, or French (please provide sheet music for the pianist)
- VOCALISES: for range, dynamics and colour; led by Michael Zaugg
- SIGHT-READING: quick study, handed out 10 min. prior to audition (please bring a tuning fork or pitch pipe)

**PLEASE NOTE:**

- Audition Fee - \$25, payable before audition by cheque (payable to Pro Coro Canada) or cash.
- Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to your audition to receive the quick study piece.
